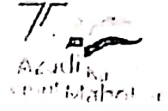



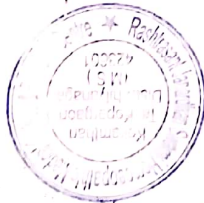

Decision/Order of the Commission आयोग का निर्णय /आदेश

Appeal of Rashtrasant Janardhan Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre, Opposite Deaf and Dumb School, At Post Bet, taluka Kopergaon, Ahmednagar, Maharashtra-423601 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 60 seats for the academic year 2025-26.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with a mandate to grant permission for the continuation of 1st BHMS course. Accordingly relevant documents submitted by the college, which were examined as per MES Regulation, 2024 by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for permission matter.

The MARBH conducted an inspection on 12.06.2025 & 13.06.2025, followed by hearing on 03.07.2025. However, based on the inspection report & hearing report MARBH vide letter no. 4-7/MARBH/NCH/2025-26 (115-53)/4199 dated 03.07.2025 decided denial of permission to Rashtrasant Janardhan Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre, Opposite Deaf and Dumb School, At Post Bet, taluka Kopergaon, Ahmednagar, Maharashtra-423601 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 60 seats for the academic year 2025-26.

Aggrieved by this, the college appealed to NCH vide its letter Ref. no. RJSF/BHMS/3013/2025 dated 21.07.2025 received by Commission on 24.07.2025 and submitted further clarification/ documents. Upon examination of further documents, the following observations have been made:

Observations of commission

General observation

MARBH has decided to issue denial of permission to the college citing lack of teaching faculty in the department. The college has requested to reconsider, the existing infrastructure, ongoing efforts in faculty recruitment. The College has taken steps regarding compliance including faculty appointments.

Point-wise observation of Committee:

1. Teaching faculty.

- No Assistant professor in the department of physiology. Two Assistant Professor, namely Dr. Prajakta Satput and Dr. Rohan Patil appointed. Both the teachers are not NTET qualified. Hence deficiency persists. Dr. Vinaya Acharya joined as assistant professor on 21.10.2025 so presently she is not eligible to be promoted as associate professor. According to MES 2024 experience should be minimum of 5 yrs to get promoted as associate professor. Hence deficiency persists
- No Professor in the department of Organon. Dr. Bhausaheb Ramdas, Halnor was appointed for the post of professor. Relieving letter from the past college is not provided. Hence deficiency persists.



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- c) No Professor in the department of Community Medicine. No appointment done. Hence deficiency

2. Hospital functioning

- d) ✓ Surgeon and dietician on call. As per MES 2024 surgeon should be on a full-time basis. But Dr. Rajesh Mali is on call. Hence deficiency persists. As per MES 2024 dietician should be on a full-time basis. Dr. Kavita Choudhari is working on a full-time basis at Shri Janardhan Swami Hospital. So, deficiency persists.
- e) USG, ECG, Lab investigation not available, done at MoU. Photographic evidence and certificate provided by the college. Hence deficiency resolved.
- f) On 12.06.2025 at around 10:22 a.m., no patients were available in OPD. After lunch time, 8-10 patients were available. College has not mentioned a valid reason for low patient count. Deficiency persists. (4)
- g) In IPD around 21 patients were admitted in the hospital but in their case record reportorial sheet, diagnosis was missing. Proper IPD case records are submitted by the college. Hence deficiency resolved.

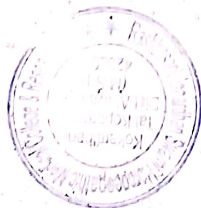
3. Miscellaneous:

- a) ✓ Registered on AEBAS portal but no data available. AEBAS machine installed but the machine is not functioning. Deficiency persists. ✓
- b) ✓ NABL accreditation for clinical laboratories not done. Deficiency persists. ✓
- c) ✓ NABH accreditation is not done. Entry level certificate submitted, fees not submitted. Deficiency persists. ✓
- d) Yoga Unit-Available but not functioning. College has submitted photographic evidence and certificate of yoga instructor. Hence deficiency resolved. ✓
- e) METU-Available but not functioning. College has submitted photographic evidence. Hence deficiency resolved. ✓
- f) Clinical teaching room not available. Clinical teaching room not as per MES 2024. Hence deficiency persists. ✓
- g) The salary of teaching staff and non-teaching staff is not as per MES 2024. Hence deficiency persists. ✓

4. Virtual visitation on 31.07.2025 (GRC meeting)

Notice for virtual visitation was sent to college on 31.07.2025 and link was sent on 31.07.2025 at 10:30 a.m. to the college for virtual visitation to check the functionality of the College and Hospital. The Expert committee connected for about one hour, but the college representative could not connect properly. Call was disconnected many times. Some of the observations during visitations were.

- a) Only one MO in surgery OPD was giving input.
- b) While IPD round no bedsheets were there on the beds of the admitted patients. IPD patients could not tell their complaints. Hence the genuine functionality of the hospital could not be established.
- c) No smart board in METU department
- d) Only 01 clinical teaching room present.

Overall observations by committee

Overall observation:

1. The appointment of teaching faculty is not as per MES 2024.
 2. It is observed from the submission and documents submitted in appeal that the hospital is not functioning as required for treating patients as well for learning purposes of the students. The Collegiate hospital is also lacking to fulfill important provisions of MES 2024.
 3. Registered on AEBAS portal but no data available.
 4. NABL Accreditation for clinical laboratories is not done.
 5. NABH Accreditation is under process. Entry level certificate submitted, fees not submitted.
 6. Now, THEREFORE, the Commission has decided to reiterate the decision of MARBH vide letter dated 03.07.2024 for denial of permission of BHMS course with intake capacity of 60 seats for the academic session 2025-26.
- I. Accordingly, your representation dated 21.07.2024 to Commission against MARBH letter dated 03.07.2024 stands disposed off.
- II. If aggrieved with the above decision, as per NCH Act 2020, may place a second appeal to the Central Government within 7 days of issue of this communication of above decision

Rashtrasant Janardhan Swami Homoeopathic Medical College has applied for permission for sanction of BIIMS course with 60 seats for the academic year 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted the inspection on 12.06.2025 & 13.06.2025, followed by hearing on 03.07.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls: -

1. Teaching faculty.

- Assistant professor in the department of physiology.
- Professor in the department of organon.
- Professor in the department of community medicine.

As evident from above one teacher is deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 60 seats UG college (As specified in MES,2024). Pursuant to F.No.:3- 2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dated 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 15% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 15%, college has no deficiency in teaching faculty. However, such a relaxed number of teachers may be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

2. Hospital functioning

- Surgeon and dietician on call.
- USG, ECG, Lab investigation not available, done at MoU.
- On 12.06.2025 at around 10:22 a.m., no patients were available in OPD. After lunch time, 8-10 patients were available.
- In IPD around 21 patients were admitted in the hospital but in their case record repertorial sheet, diagnosis was missing.

3. Miscellaneous

- Registered on AEBAS portal but no data available.
- NABL accreditation for clinical laboratories not done
NABH accreditation is not done.
- Yoga Unit - Available but not functioning
- METU - Available but not functioning

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- Clinical teaching room not available.

Notice with above mentioned deficiencies for virtual hearing was sent to college on 02.07.2025 and link was sent on 03.07.2025 at 10:00 a.m. to the college for verification of functionality of the College and Hospital. Expert committee connected for one hour, but the college representative did not join from their side.

- Repeated requests on mobile were made by NCH representative to join but college representative kept on giving excuses that they shall join after some time.
 - Even after waiting from 10:00 am to 11:00 am, the college authority didn't join.
4. Since college did not attend pre notified virtual hearing on 03.07.2025, MARBH has decided to issue denial of permission to Rashtrasant Janardhan Swami Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre, Opposite Deaf and Dumb School, At Post Bet, taluka Kopergaon, Ahmednagar, Maharashtra-423601 for functioning for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 60 seats for the academic year 2025-26.
5. If the College is aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board, college may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulations 2024, section 14 subsection (1) and NCH General Regulation 2023 'section 22. The Manner of instructions for appeal are attached.

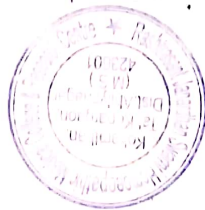
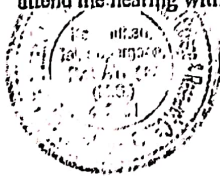

Rashtrasant Janardhan Swami Foundation, Rashtrasant Janardhan Homoeopathic Medical College and Research centre, Opposite Deaf and Dumb School, At Post Bet. taluka Kopargaon, Ahmednagar, Maharashtra-423601 is functional since 2022 and has applied for permission for sanction of UG (BHMS) course with 100 seats for the academic year 2024-2025. The college has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the college as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under the NCH Act 2020.

On careful examination of the part-I information and inspection held on 12th and 13th July 2024 the following shortfalls have been observed by Medical Assessment and Rating Board which affects the functionality of the college and hospital as per MSR requirements:

a) Hospital details

- During rounds in the OPD only two OPD's were with doctors, no patients at the time of visit.
- The hospital has Geriatrics OPD but no doctor was found in OPD during the inspection rounds.
- No nursing staff was seen during the rounds on both days in IPD/OPD.

b) Teaching Faculty

- There is no Professor in the department of Repertory.
- 04 guest faculties are available against the requirement of 12.

c) Miscellaneous

- Form-16 is not submitted from traces portal.

SHORTCOMING – 1 (Teaching Faculty)

Shortcoming – a

- No Assistant professor in the department of physiology. Two Assistant Professor, namely Dr. Prajakta Satpute and Dr. Rohan Patil appointed. Both the teachers are not NTET qualified. Hence deficiency persists. Dr. Vinaya Acharya joined as assistant professor on 21.10.2025 so presently she is not eligible to be promoted as associate professor. According to MES 2024 experience should be minimum of 5 yrs to get promoted as associate professor. Hence deficiency persists.

Explanation/Clarification

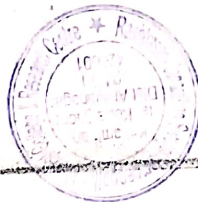
- Dr. Prajakta Satpute and Dr. Rohan Patil appeared for the NTET in June 2025 but did not qualify. Accordingly, Dr. Kanchan Pawar and Dr. Nikita Dhas have been appointed as Assistant Professors in the Department of Physiology Including Biochemistry.
- A copy of his appointment order, joining letter, relieving order from the previous institute and other relevant supporting documents are enclosed herewith for your kind perusal and verification.
- We also request consideration for the promotion of Dr. Vinaya Acharya, who joined as Assistant Professor on 22/09/2021 and will complete four years of service on 21/09/2025. With only 1.5 months remaining to complete the required tenure, we respectfully urge the Commission to consider her for the post of Associate Professor, in fairness to her continuous service and commitment to the institution.
- An offer letter from the Chairman of the Trust, assuring the appointment of Dr. Vinaya Acharya as Associate Professor, is enclosed herewith for your kind perusal.

Shortcoming – b

- No Professor in the department of Organon. Dr. Bhausaheb Ramdas Halnor was appointed for the post of professor. Relieving letter from the past college is not provided.

- To fulfil the requirement of a Professor in the Department of Organon, the college has appointed Dr. Bhausaheb Ramdas Halnor to the said position.
- A copy of his appointment order, joining letter, relieving order from the previous institute, and other relevant supporting documents are enclosed herewith for your kind perusal and verification.



Shortcoming – c

- No Professor in the department of Community Medicine. No appointment done. Hence deficiency

Explanation/Clarification

- To fulfil the requirement for a Professor in the Department of Community Medicine, the college has issued an offer letter to Dr. Vaibhav Mahajan for the said position, with the condition that he join the college effective from 15.08.2025.
- A copy of the offer letter issued to Dr. Mahajan is enclosed herewith for your kind perusal and verification.
- I would like to make a humble submission that, as per the MES,2024 (for 100 intake capacity), the status of fulltime teaching faculty appointed at Rashtrasant Janardhan Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Ahmednagar is as follows.

- Rashtrasant Janardhan Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Ahmednagar was established in the academic year 2021-22 with an annual intake of 100 seats.
- As per MARBH letter No. 3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/1162-169 dated 16.04.2025, regarding relaxation in certain provisions of the *National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals), Regulations 2024*, a 10% relaxation in teaching staff is permitted for colleges with 100 UG seats and 15% relaxation for those with 60 UG seats.



- Accordingly, the college currently has 39 teaching staff against the required 40, which falls within the permissible relaxation limit.
- In view of the above, we humbly request the Commission to kindly grant approval for 100 BHMS seats for the academic year 2025-26.

SHORTCOMING – 2 (Hospital Functioning)

Shortcoming – d.

- Surgeon and dietician on call. As per MES 2024 surgeon should be on a full-time basis. But Dr. Rajesh Mali is on call. Hence deficiency persists. As per MES 2024 dietician should be on a full-time basis. Dr. Kavita Choudhary is working on a full-time basis at Shri Janardhan Swami Hospital. So, deficiency persists.

Explanation/Clarification

- To fulfil the requirement of a full-time Surgeon in the hospital, the college has appointed Dr. Tejas Sonawane (M.B.B.S., M.S.) to the said position.
- Additionally, to address the deficiency of a full-time Dietitian, Ms. Vaishnavi Bibin Shinde, holding a Master's degree in Food and Nutrition, has been appointed accordingly.
- Copies of their appointment orders, joining letters, and other relevant supporting documents are enclosed herewith for your kind perusal and verification.

Shortcoming – f.

- On 12.06.2025 at around 10:22 a.m., no patients were available in OPD. After lunch time, 8-10 patients were available. College has not mentioned a valid reason for low patient count. Deficiency persists.

Explanation/Clarification

- The Homoeopathic Hospital and College is located in a rural area with limited public transportation facilities. Although the OPD officially starts at 09:30 AM, many patients generally begin arriving around 10:00 AM onwards due to travel constraints.
- Additionally, the institution is situated adjacent to the Nagar-Manmad highway, which is currently under construction, further impeding easy access to the hospital premises.
- It is also pertinent to mention that the day of inspection (12.06.2025) was a rainy day, which may have contributed to delays in patient arrival.
- Despite these temporary challenges, once the hospital operations commence for the day, we receive an average footfall of 250 patients daily, as substantiated by the certified copy of the OPD attendance records attached herewith for your kind verification.
- Moreover, on the day of the hearing held on 31.07.2025 at 10:30 a.m., the OPD was fully functional, with 18 patients present at the time.
- We hope this explanation is taken into consideration while reviewing the inspection observations.
- On the day of inspection, the inspectors observed the OPD waiting area post-lunch during which time some patients and their relatives were also away for lunch, resulting in a smaller crowd being present at that moment.



- However, on the day of the hearing held on 31/07/2025 at 11:11 a.m., there were 13-14 patients waiting outside the OPD, and 12 patient names were recorded in the General Homoeopathy Register.
- Notably, a total of 263 patients were attended to in the OPD on that day.
- We respectfully request that these facts be taken into consideration while reviewing the observations related to OPD functionality.

SHORTCOMING – 3 (Miscellaneous)

Shortcoming – a.

- College registered on AEBAS portal but no data available.

Explanation/Clarification

- The college has successfully registered and activated the AEBAS portal. The biometric attendance system has been implemented. Any delay in data visibility was due to initial technical configurations, which have since been resolved.
- We kindly request the Commission to consider this update during the review process.

Shortcoming – b.

- NABL accreditation for clinical laboratories not done.

Explanation/Clarification

- This is to inform you that the process for NABL accreditation is currently underway to ensure that our clinical laboratory meets the required standards of technical competence and quality assurance as mandated by national norms.
- Furthermore, we would like to mention that all advanced diagnostic investigations are referred to and conducted at Shree Janardhan Swami Hospital, which is located within the same campus. This ensures timely and reliable access to necessary diagnostic services for all patients.
- We remain committed to continuous improvement and adherence to all regulatory standards.

Shortcoming – c.

- NABH accreditation is not done. Entry level certificate submitted, fees not submitted.

Explanation/Clarification

- NABH accreditation is currently in process. The Entry-Level Certification has been submitted, and the accreditation fee payment is pending, which will be completed shortly. The college is in the process of uploading the necessary documents to move forward with the accreditation procedure.

Shortcoming – f.

- Clinical teaching room not available.



Explanation/Clarification

- We would like to clarify that three Clinical Teaching Rooms are available in our institution.
- These rooms are well-equipped with essential teaching aids and infrastructure to support effective clinical demonstrations, small group discussions, and interactive learning sessions for undergraduate students. They are actively utilized by faculty for conducting bedside teaching, case presentations, and other clinical training activities as part of the academic curriculum.
- We remain committed to upholding the standards prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH) and to the continuous enhancement of our teaching and clinical facilities.

Shortcoming – f.

- Salary of teaching staff and non-teaching staff is not as per MES 2024.

Explanation/Clarification

- I wish to inform you that necessary steps are being taken with regard to the salary of teaching and non-teaching staff. We assure you that the revised salary structure, as per the MES 2024 norms, will be duly implemented with effect from the upcoming academic year as follows.

Explanation/Clarification

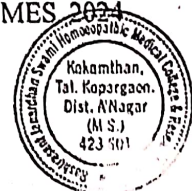
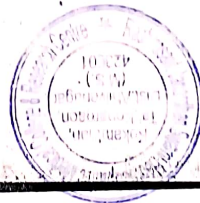

- In addition, the college has appointed a full-time Surgeon, Dr. Tejas Sonawane (M.B.B.S., M.S.), to fulfill the surgical requirement as per norms.
- During the inspection, one MO was accompanying a patient to the laboratory, while RMO Dr. Anirudhha Ubale was present in the ward, where he also interacted with the inspection committee.

Shortcoming – b.

- While IPD round no bedsheets were there on the beds of the admitted patients. IPD patients could not tell their complaints. Hence the genuine functionality of hospital could not be established.

Explanation/Clarification

- During the IPD round, it is regretted that bedsheets were temporarily unavailable on some patient beds. This was due to the ongoing change of linen as part of routine housekeeping protocol. We assure you that fresh, clean bedsheets are provided daily, and patient hygiene and comfort are maintained as per norms.
- Regarding the communication with IPD patients, some of them may have been resting or unable to articulate their complaints clearly at the time of the visit. However, we would like to assure the Commission that all patients admitted are genuine, and their medical records, treatment plans, and progress notes are duly maintained and available for verification.
- The hospital remains fully functional, and we are committed to maintaining all standards of patient care and documentation in accordance with MES 2024 guidelines.



Shortcoming - c.

- No smart board in METU department

Explanation/Clarification

- We would like to clarify that the METU (Medical Education Technology Unit) department is equipped with a Smart Board and projector to facilitate modern teaching and training methods.
- These digital tools are regularly utilized during faculty development programs, interactive sessions, and academic presentations, in line with the objectives of the METU.

Shortcoming - d.

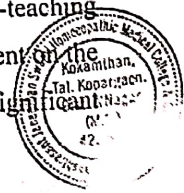
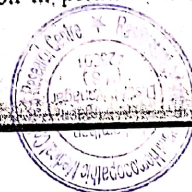
- Only 01 clinical teaching room present.

Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the college as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under the NCH Act 2020.

On careful examination of the part-I information and inspection held on 12th and 13th July 2024 the following shortfalls have been observed by Medical Assessment and Rating Board which affects the functionality of the college and hospital as per MSR requirements:

- Hospital details**
 - During rounds in the OPD only two OPD's were with doctors, no patients at the time of visit.
 - The hospital has Geriatrics OPD but no doctor was found in OPD during the inspection rounds.
 - No nursing staff was seen during the rounds on both days in IPD/OPD.
- Teaching Faculty**
 - There is no Professor in the department of Repertory.
 - 04 guest faculties are available against the requirement of 12.
- Miscellaneous**
 - Form-16 is not submitted from traces portal.
 - No pathology and microbiology lab attendant is available
 - 01 centrifuge is available against the requirement of 02.
 - Auditorium is not well furnished.

Considering the above observations, Medical Assessment and Rating Board has decided to issue Conditional permission to Rashtrasant Janardhan Swami Foundation, Rashtrasant Janardhan Homoeopathic Medical College and Research centre, Opposite Deaf and Dumb School, At Post Bet, taluka Kopargaon, Ahmednagar, Maharashtra-423601 for conducting UG (BHMS) course with reduced student intake of 60 seats for the academic year 2024-2025.

All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and compliance report shall be submitted for verification.


All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling authority of State/UT Govt as designated by Central Government/NCH and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.

The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

Permission to college can be withdrawn or denied in the subsequent year if college is found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 anytime during the academic year.


If the College is aggrieved with the above decision, College may place an appeal to the National Commission for Homoeopathy as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulation 2024, section 14 sub-section (3) and NCH (General Regulations) 2023, section 22 within a period of 30 days. Manner of submission of appeal is attached herewith.

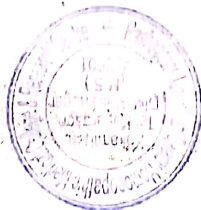

The same can be verified from the Hospital Deadstock Registers as well as Purchase bills of hospital equipment. Submitted copy of Hospital equipment Dead Stock Register, Hospital equipment purchase bills and photographs of 04 ENT Diagnostic set available at hospital.

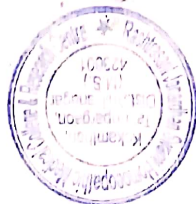

College has informed that cadaver will be made available after obtaining the LOP because without LOP Government of Maharashtra will not issue notification under Anatomy Act to procure the Cadaver to our college. Mummified Bodies. Soft part wet and dry are available at Anatomy Department of the College. The same can be verified from the Dead Stock Register of Anatomy Department as well as the purchase bills. The copy of Anatomy Act is available at Anatomy Department. Also, the College has signed MOU with Rastrasant Janardhan Swami College of Physiotherapy which is situated in the same campus having the Anatomy Act which is also a college run by the same trust- Rastrasant Janardhan Swami Foundation. Thus, College fulfills all requirement of Anatomy Department as per MSR 2013. Observation:

Commission observed that Mummified Bodies, Soft part (wet and dry) are available at Anatomy Department of the College. Committee verified the Dead Stock Register as well as the purchase bills of Anatomy Department and found satisfactory. A copy of MOU (dated 17/11/2021 & valid for 02 years) with Rastrasant Janardhan Swami College of Physiotherapy registered with Medical Education & drugs Department under Maharashtra Anatomy Act, 1949 is submitted. Both institutions are run by the Rastrasant Janardhan Swami Foundation and situated in the same campus. As per MOU, both parties are agreeing for facilitating cadaver dissection to first BHMS students. Photographs of mummified bodies, soft part wet and dry submitted. Therefore, the College fulfills all requirement for Anatomy Department as per MSR 2013.

Submission of College to Commission:

Observations of Hearing Committee & MA&RB vide letter dated 17/12/2021 mentioned that Physiology & Biochemistry- Tuning forks to test hearing (32-10000 Hz) and Centre hot plate, not available.

College informed that tuning forks to test hearing (256hz) and centre hot plate are available at Physiology & Biochemistry Lab. The same can be verified from the Dead Stock Register of Physiology Department as well as the purchase of bills. Thus the college fulfills all the requirements of Physiology Department as per MSR 2013.


Observation:

Commission examined the Dead Stock Register and purchase of bills to ascertain the availability of tuning forks to test hearing (256 hz) and centre hot plate in Physiology & Biochemistry Lab. Documents were found satisfactory.

Submission of College to Commission:

Observations of Hearing Committee & MA&RB vide letter dated 17/12/2021 mentioned that Homoeopathic Pharmacy: License for procuring alcohol, Thin layer chromatography apparatus not available, Physical Balance Not available, Chemicals not available Specimens and vehicles not available.

The College has obtained the license for procuring alcohol for educational purpose from State Excise Department of Maharashtra. Thin Layer chromatography apparatus, physical balance, chemicals, specimens and vehicles are available as per MSR 2013. Same can be verified from the Dead Stock register of Homoeopathic Pharmacy department as well as purchase bills.

Observation:

College has submitted the license for procuring alcohol valid up to 31/03/2022 from District Authority, Ahmednagar. Dendstock register and purchase bills of Thin Layer chromatography apparatus (bills dated 16/07/2020) received. Specimens and vehicles are purchased (bills dated 25/07/2020). Photos of Physical Balance & Chemicals (Bills dated 16/07/2020) are available. Commission observed that the College is having facilities for Department of Pharmacy as per Schedule III, MSR, 2013.

Submission of College to Commission:

Observations of Hearing Committee & MA&RB vide letter dated 17/12/2021 mentioned that Teachings Faculty: a. No lecturer available in the department of Anatomy. b. No Professor or reader available in department of pharmacy c. No Faculty available in department of physiology

a College appointed on full time basis in the department of Anatomy from 01/03/2021 Dr Pawar Vijay Parashram. He was present at the time of LOI inspection. He was on leave on the day of LOP inspection due to health issues. He is attending the college regularly. The fact can be verified from his appointment order, joining report, affidavit, College teaching faculty attendance register of the college faculty. b. The college has appointed Dr Patil Yashwantrao Baliram as an Associate Professor/ Reader in the Department of Homeopathic Pharmacy. c. The college has appointed Dr Acharya Vinaya Anil as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Physiology including Biochemistry from 01/11/2021 and was interviewed by the inspection team. The same can be verified from video recording of the LOP inspection. Unfortunately, in the denial letter of LOP inspection it is mentioned that no faculty is available in the department of Physiology. The college has appointed Dr. Sharma Shelly Satish Kumar as an Associate Professor/Reader in the Department of Physiology & Biochemistry.

Observation:

College has submitted the Appointment order, affidavit for Dr Pawar Vijay Parashram, Anatomy, Dr Patil Yashwantrao Baliram as an Associate Professor/ Reader in the Department of Homeopathic Pharmacy and Dr Acharya Vinaya Anil as Assistant professor in the Department of Physiology and Dr. Sharma Shelly Satishkumar as Associate Professor in the Department of Physiology & Biochemistry. After examination, it is observed that College appointed sufficient teaching faculty for Department of Anatomy, Department of Pharmacy & Department of Physiology. Hence, this point does not exist.

Submission of College to Commission:

Observations of Hearing Committee & MA&RB vide letter dated 17/12/2021 mentioned that Bank Guarantee in original not received.


The required Bank Guarantee Bank of Maharashtra dated 14/12/2021 submitted. 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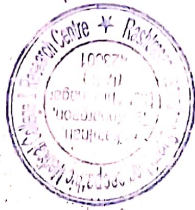




